Disaster relief is a round the clock job that requires powerful teamwork, so creating a strong sense of community for his staff is paramount to Almaraz. He and his staff meet daily to discuss projects, service values and bolster communication. “The key to building and inspiring a world class team is empowering them to bring their skills, knowledge and ideas to the table,” Almaraz shares. “People want to work for a cause more than a paycheck, so it is my role to invest in them to create a team of leaders.”
